
1100-0531 with brackets instruction sheet




- *Parts not supplied with kit
- REMOVE EXISTING GENERATOR, MOUNTING BRACKET(S), WIRING HARNESS, AND VOLTAGE REGULATOR
- INSTALL NEW 12V ALTERNATOR WITH BRACKETS SUPPLIED (SEE DIAGRAM)
- INSTALL COIL RESISTOR SUPPLIED, REFERENCE WIRING DIAGRAM TO INSTALL WIRING HARNESS (ALL BULBS MUST BE CHANGED TO 12V)
- INSTALL 12V, NEGATIVE GROUND, BATTERY. CHECK BATTERY TERMINAL ON ALTERNATOR, IT SHOULD BE HOT AT ALL TIMES.
- START TRACTOR. AS ENGINE SPEED INCREASES, ALTERNATOR WILL BEGIN TO CHARGE.

NOTE:

After long periods of no use or disassembly, it may be necessary to re=-excite the alternator. With the engine running use a jumper wire between the battery and "R" terminal.
